Group Connections:

Parents as Teachers sponsors group connections, which are usually fun activities for parents and their young children to do together. Group connections provide children an opportunity to learn to play with others and try new activities and parents can meet and share experiences. Examples of previous group connections include Young Artists, Fall Fun, Stretch-n-Grow, and BLOCKFest.

Screenings:

Parents as Teachers provides developmental screenings to children enrolled in our program. We screen in the areas of communication, gross motor, fine motor, problem solving, and personal social skills. We provide a specific screening for social-emotional development. We also provide functional hearing assessments using the Otoacoustic emissions instrument and vision screenings using the SPOT. The screenings are provided at no charge to the family.
