Animals in the Classroom:


- Must have prior approval from teacher and building principal

REMINDERS

Please Read

- Arrival: Please wait until 7:45 to enter the building. Adults are in the building at this time which allows us to monitor and keep students safe.
- Car Loop: Drop students off in the west parking lot. Remember to stay in your vehicle and pull all the way forward. Please do not drop students off in the east parking lot between the playground and school. This is for buses only. (video coming soon)
- Going Home Changes: Please call before 3:00 if you wish to make a change to how your child goes home for the day. We need time to communicate the changes to bus drivers and teachers.
- School Start Time: School starts at 8:10. Many important components such as announcements, lunch count, homework check, and morning work happen from 8:10-8:30.
- Absences: Please call the office to inform us if your child will be staying home. Doctor's notes will be mandatory after the 8th absence.
- Visiting the School: If you wish to stop by and see your child please do so during recess or lunch. Please be certain to sign-in at the office first.
- **Breakfast and Lunch:** The cafeteria is now providing many new choices to our students. Be sure to check it out!
- **Communication:** We will use a weekly newsletter, facebook, school messenger, and email to communicate info.
- How Can You Help: Please read with your child at least 3 times per week. As well do math flash cards, count money, and try some online math games. These activities will help with retention and are a great way to strengthen the relationship with your child.
- **Volunteer:** Would you like to help out? Please call and ask to complete a volunteer form. It can be all day, one hour, or help with our lunch time.
