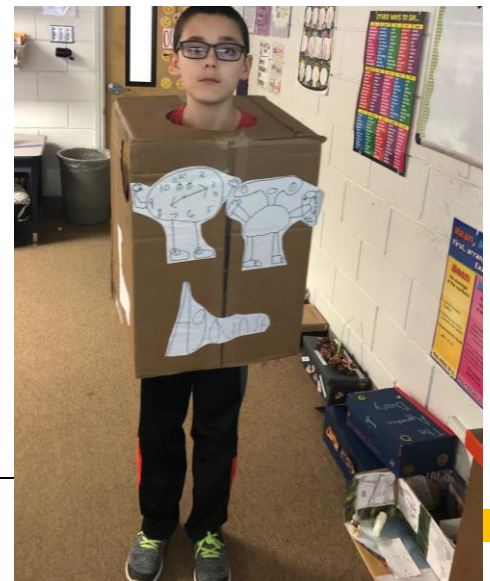
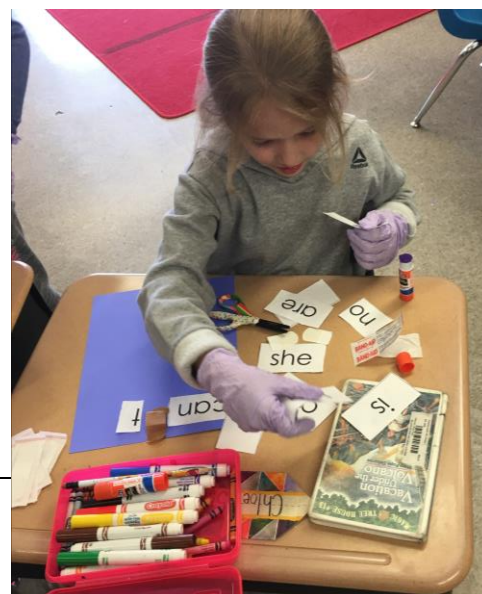
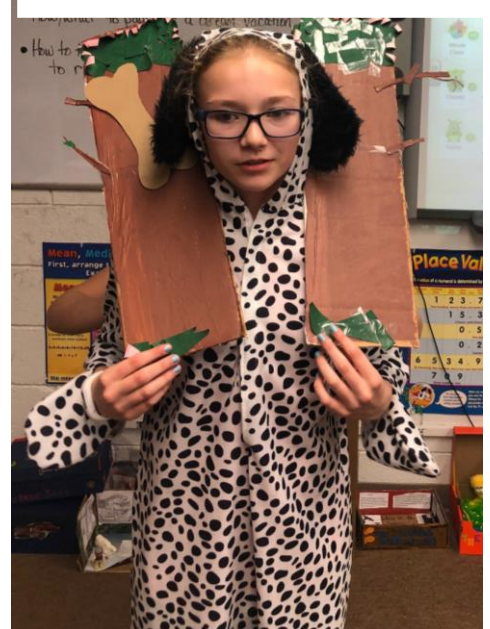

Dear Parents / Guardians,

Field Day is just around the corner! This annual event will take place on Thursday, May 2nd located at the McLouth Football Stadium. Considering the success of the past Field Days, we will continue participating in several stations which will focus on classic games, track events, sports activities, relay activities, and target games that will focus on individual skills, strategy and teamwork; followed by Class Challenges!

Field Day will be split into two sessions: a morning session (9:00 - 10:45am) and an afternoon session (1:00 - 3:00pm). There will be a Lunch/Restroom Break in between the morning & afternoon sessions. The Team/Class Challenges will take place towards the end of Field Day and will consist of the Tug-of-War Challenge, Water Relays, and a Running Challenge. The Running Challenge is optional, so the students do not have to run in the event. K & 1st graders will run 400m (1 lap), 2nd & 3rd graders will run 800m (2 laps), and 4th & 5th grades will run a mile (4 laps)! We would love for you to come watch and support your child(ren) during Field Day.

- There will not be an opportunity for adults to purchase a school lunch. If you decided to eat lunch with your child(ren), please remember to bring your own lunch.

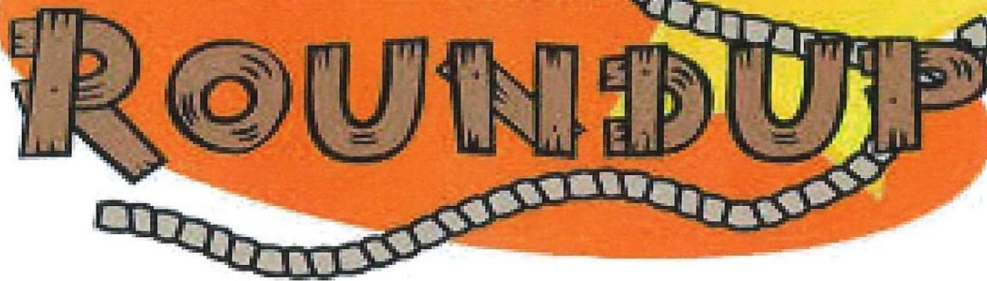
