**If you are interested in taking Drivers Education this summer**, please pick up the informational packet with enrollment forms and details about the program. The sooner Mrs. Harriman knows the better chance she can successfully accommodate the various needs. Students must be available from June 1st - 14th for the course work - no exceptions. Here's an excerpt from the informational packet on class work dates... "The classroom portion of the driver's education class begins Wednesday, June 1, 2022 and ends Tuesday, June 14th. Attendance is very important; we cover as many as three chapters on a given day: do not miss class! Classroom times are from 8:30 to 12:00; I plan to arrive at 8:00 each day. If you need to make up work, you will be required to come in at 8:00. Missed class time must be made up prior to June 14th. If you miss class 3 times, you will be dismissed from the class; even missing one day can be difficult to make up. Do not miss class!"

## **MIDDLE SCHOOL:**

**Summer Driver Education** will be available this year to any student that is an eight grade graduate and who will be fourteen years of age prior to the first day of class, June 1, 2022.
