HIGH SCHOOL:

King and Queen of Courts Dance will be Friday, February 2nd

<u>Time:</u> The dance will not have a set time, but will begin immediately following the HS basketball games. Students will have 30 minutes from the end of the basketball games to enter the dance. From that point, the dance will be 2 hours long. (Essentially, the dance will end 2.5 hours after the conclusion of the basketball games). For example, if the games end at 8:30, you have until 9:00 to enter the dance, and the dance will end at 11:00.

Location: School cafeteria. Enter the dance through the north parking lot doors next to the purple gym. You will not be able to go through the school to get back to the south student parking lot after the dance, so it is advised that you park in the north parking lot before coming to the dance.

No late entrance of reentry: If you are not in the dance by the time the doors are locked (30 minutes after the end of the basketball games), you will not be allowed entrance. If you leave after that time, you will not be allowed to reenter the dance.

<u>Guests</u>: Only currently enrolled HS students are already approved to participate. Anyone else is categorized as a guest. Guests must be preapproved by the office using the guest form (found at the office). Guests must be classified as high school (or graduate no older than 20).

Behavior Expectations: This is a school sponsored event. Therefore, all behavior must be consistent with school policy. Failure to follow school expectations will result in removal from the dance and/or school approved discipline.
