Parade Floats:

Floats need to be parked in the Methodist Church parking lot across from the high school by 8:00 am on Friday, September 29th. Floats will be judged during 1st hour. An adult will need to drive the vehicle pulling the float in the parade.

Buff-N-Tuff Football/Powder Puff Football/Scavenger Hunt/Tug of War/Bonfire:

Talent Show/Parade/Pep Rally and Candidate Games:

The talent show will take place at the school prior to the parade. Talent show start time is TBD. The parade following the talent show is tentatively set for 2:15pm on Friday, September 29. The pep rally and candidate games will be held downtown at Luse Park (City Park) after the parade.

Parade Route:

North on Summit, east on West Agnes, north on Union, west on West Cynthia. As the parade reaches Cynthia St, students will return to Luse park (City Park) for the pep rally.

Homecoming Dance:

The dance will be Friday night (September 29) following the football game. Cost is \$3/attendee. There will be pizza and drinks provided.

- Out-of-school guests must be pre-approved by administration.
- Students must be academically eligible.
- Students must be present in school all day of the activity. Exceptions will be made for a planned absence or medical appointment (excused by a doctor's note).
- Attendees have 45 minutes from the end of the game to enter the dance. No entrance after that.
- If a student leaves the dance, they may not return.
- The dance will end by midnight.

Out of District Guests:

Students who are taking out-of-school guests to the Homecoming Dance will need to complete a "Request for Out-of-School Guest" form.

- Only one guest will be allowed per MHS student. Guests must enter the dance with their host MHS student.
- Guests must have a minimum classification of Freshman and must be younger than 21 years old.
- The forms can be obtained outside of the HS office and must be returned to the HS office by Friday, September 25.
