Questions for Parents - for students doing the "student-led" conference

- **Do we need to prepare anything?** All materials will be at school, just bring yourself.
- **Do we need to dress up?** please wear comfortable clothes, students may dress up if they wish.
- Will there be time to ask our child questions after his/her presentation? Yes, and sample questions will be provided.
- Can we have our child practice at home or ask them questions about their presentation? -Yes, it would be beneficial to have your child demonstrate or discuss their presentation at home as this will better prepare them for success.
- What will my child be presenting? Each student in grades 3-5 will present samples of academics, behavior, successes, and areas to improve upon.

Will my child be graded over their presentation? No, this will not affect their class grades but there will be a rubric/checklist, self-assessment and teacher assessment that students will follow to prepare for their presentation.

In an effort to make student-led conferences as beneficial as possible, below is a list of questions to ask your child as you sit down and review his/her portfolio of work together.

- Why do you think you received this grade for this work?
- Was this grade a fair assessment of the work you did?
- How much time did you devote to this project/paper?
- What would you say is your best subject?
- What do you enjoy the most about school?
- Do you participate in class discussions and activities?
- Do you interact with your teacher well?
- Is there something you wish your teacher knew about you?
- Do you work well with a partner?
- Are there times when you prefer to work alone?
- What strengths or weaknesses do you bring to group projects?
- Who do you sit with at lunch?
- Is there someone in your class that you wish you knew better?
