After reading p. 165

What words would you use to describe Jackie?

Answer: curly hair, short, tries hard, smart, doesn't make good decisions

Why did you choose those words?

Answer: The picture shows what she looks like. She tries to sell the cow to many people. She doesn't believe what the woman says about the beans because she knows what plants need to grow. Even so, she decides to take the beans because she doesn't want to haul the cow home.

After reading p. 168

 How does Jackie feel when she realizes Mr. FeFifofum thinks she stole the harp? Tell how you know.

Answer: She feels guilty because she only meant to borrow the harp. She hides in her closet and looks sad.

What does she do to feel better?

Answer: She gives the harp back, apologizes, and explains what happened.

What do these actions tell you about Jackie?

Answer: She is willing to learn from her mistakes. She realizes she shouldn't have taken the harp without asking first. She can admit when she is wrong.
