

Beginning Sound Bingo

The phonological awareness tab is geared more towards the 4 year old group due to 4 year old standards. 3 year olds have not been introduced to most of these concepts yet but if you wish to try, feel free but don't work to the point of frustration.

*This board is an example on how to set up. You can draw a Bingo board and add letters to each box with the Free Space in the middle. Your child can use coins, cereal, toys, anything that will work as counters to cover letters.

You can make cards with words to call out for the game, if you call them out from the top of your head that's ok too, just make sure you remember the words you call out to check at the end.

Example: Adult "bag" ...child covers "B"Adult "doll" child doesn't cover anything because they don't have the letter D.

You can play until the child has a Bingo-(3 in a row) or even Black out (when all spaces are covered).
