## Fishing for Beginning Sounds

The phonological awareness tab is geared more towards the 4 year old group due to 4 year old standards. 3 year olds have not been introduced to most of these concepts yet but if you wish to try, feel free but don't work to the point of frustration.



## There are a few different ways to do this activity

- 1. You can tie a string to a stick or rod and then attach a magnet to the string. You can place paper clips on the paper fish or just pieces of paper or letter cards. They can fish by themselves
- 2. Or you can tie a string to a stick or rod and then attach a paperclip to the string. You will then have your child fish over a barrier (where they can't see you attach the fish/paper/letter card to the paper clip.

Object of the game: Your child will fish for letters. When they pull up a letter, they will say the letter name and then a word that starts with the letter.

If they are correct then they get to keep the fish/paper/letter card. If not they have to throw the letter back into the "water".
