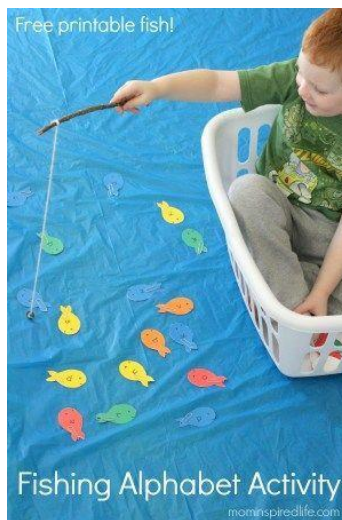


# Fishing for Beginning Sounds

The phonological awareness tab is geared more towards the 4 year old group due to 4 year old standards. 3 year olds have not been introduced to most of these concepts yet but if you wish to try, feel free but don't work to the point of frustration.



## **There are a few different ways to do this activity**

1. You can tie a string to a stick or rod and then attach a magnet to the string. You can place paper clips on the paper fish or just pieces of paper or letter cards. They can fish by themselves
2. Or you can tie a string to a stick or rod and then attach a paperclip to the string. You will then have your child fish over a barrier (where they can't see you attach the fish/paper/letter card to the paper clip).

Object of the game: Your child will fish for letters. When they pull up a letter, they will say the letter name and then a word that starts with the letter.

If they are correct then they get to keep the fish/paper/letter card. If not they have to throw the letter back into the "water".
