

RHYME SORT



First: Write words from 3 different word families on different strips of paper. Fold the words and place them in a hat

Examples:

-at

-op

-ad

(as many words as you'd like)

You will then make 3 columns with 3 strips of paper with each word family ending written on it.

Next: Have your child pick a word from the hat, you will need to read them the word.

After: Ask them which column the word belongs in (you will need to read each word family column). Then place the word under the correct word family (rhyme).

Example: The child picks “stop” “Which word does “stop” rhyme with? Stop/ at...stop/op..stop/ad?...Yes! Stop/Op” then you will place the word Stop under op. Draw another word from the hat and continue. 😊
