

Rhyming Hopscotch

The phonological awareness tab is geared more towards the 4 year old group due to 4 year old standards. 3 year olds have not been introduced to most of these concepts yet but if you wish to try, feel free but don't work to the point of frustration.



Use tape to create a hopscotch game inside, or chalk for an outside game. Have pictures inside each hopscotch square. Yell out a word, then have the child hop to the appropriate rhyming word.

You can also use a bean bag or something of the sort to toss to a picture and then they have to think of a rhyming word and hop to it.
