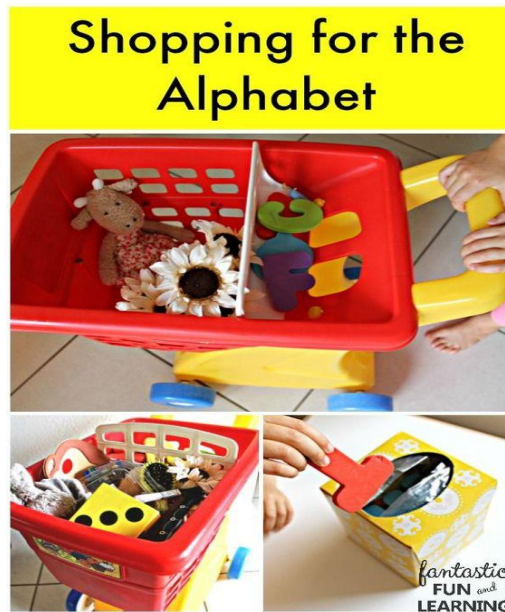


Shopping for the Alphabet

The phonological awareness tab is geared more towards the 4 year old group due to 4 year old standards. 3 year olds have not been introduced to most of these concepts yet but if you wish to try, feel free but don't work to the point of frustration.



To play: Give your child a “grocery list” with letters on it. Your child may use a bag, basket, or just stack their groceries on a table. They will go shopping around the house to look for items that start with the letters on their grocery list.

- If your child is struggling with the concept, limit their options around the house.
 - Example: If they are looking for something for the letter B- maybe introduce a candle, book, and fork and ask them which item begins with B.
