Sorting Syllables

The phonological awareness tab is geared more towards the 4 year old group due to 4 year old standards. 3 year olds have not been introduced to most of these concepts yet but if you wish to try, feel free but don't work to the point of frustration.

- 1. Find 10 objects for your child to sort
- 2. Use 1-4 number cards and spread out the cards
- 3. The child will count how many syllables for each object and then place the object on the correct number

Example: Spoon- 1, basket-2, strawberry-3, watermelon-4

Remember: Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes from Monday's video When students are saying a word they will perform the song as they say the word, if it's only one syllable their hands will be on their head, 2 syllables-shoulders, 3 syllables-knees, 4 syllables-toes.
