

Syllables 4 Corners

The phonological awareness tab is geared more towards the 4 year old group due to 4 year old standards. 3 year olds have not been introduced to most of these concepts yet but if you wish to try, feel free but don't work to the point of frustration 😊

How to Play

1. Place a number in each corner of the room 1-4
2. Call out a word, your child will count the syllables in the word (could use head, shoulders, knees, and toes method) and then they have to walk to the correct corner which is the number of correlating syllables. Example: window – 2 syllables, they will walk to the corner that has the number 2.
