


# Art Choice Board

<p><b>ABSTRACT:</b> use different drawing tools to create abstract art (remember: no pictures, just shapes, lines, &amp; colors!)</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Make up a new kind of candy. Mmm...YUM! 1<sup>ST</sup> GRADE



Week of May 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. Pick one and use any materials you have at home! Challenge yourself!

Are there other ocean animals swarming around?</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Cut out facial features from magazines, newspapers, or pictures and create funny faces with them.</p>	<p><b>TRY IT:</b> Draw and color a picture with only cool colors (Greens, Blues, &amp; Purples)</p>
<p><b>AROUND THE HOUSE:</b> Find a few objects in your house that are the same shape, then draw them.</p> 	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Create a new car or truck. What does it look like? Where is it going to take you?</p>	<p><b>TRY IT:</b> Draw and color a picture with only blacks, grays, tans, and whites.</p>

<p><b>ARRANGE IT:</b> Use found objects to make a sculpture. Glue toilet paper rolls together, draw on them, glue other things to them, crumple, cut and glue paper to them.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Draw your favorite animal eating a cupcake. Or draw your pet eating a cupcake (if you have one)!</p>	<p><b>TEAM PLAYER:</b> Use the color wheel to play "I Spy" with someone in your house.</p> 
<p><b>ART WITH MATI &amp; DADA:</b> visit on <i>YouTube</i>, pick an artist video to watch, and try to create art like the artist in the video.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Design a new building. You could create a new school or a new house. You could draw it or if you have Legos, try to build it with them!</p>	<p><b>TAKE IT OUTSIDE:</b> draw what you see outside of your house, or draw your house from outside!</p>
<p><b>AGE:</b> Draw yourself in 20 years. Where are you and what are you doing?</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Draw and color a picture with only cool colors (Greens, Blues, &amp; Purples)</p> 	<p><b>TELEPHONE:</b> call someone you know and ask them to give you an idea of something to draw.</p>

<p><b>ART WITH MATI &amp; DADA:</b> visit on <i>YouTube</i>, pick an artist video to watch, and try to create art like the artist in the video.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Design a new pair of shoes for yourself. What kind of shoes are they? What colors are they? Can they do anything special?</p>	<p><b>TEACH IT:</b> teach someone in your house something that you already know how to do in art. It could be something you draw or make.</p>
<p><b>ANIMALS:</b> draw two, or three!, or four! animals mixed together.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Draw a world where something else (besides rain and snow) fell from the sky!</p>	<p><b>TRY IT:</b> Draw and color a picture with <b>ONLY</b> complementary paired colors (red &amp; green OR blue &amp; orange OR yellow &amp; purple)</p>
<p><b>ARRANGE IT:</b> Use found objects to make a sculpture. Glue toilet paper rolls together, draw on them, glue other things to them, crumple, cut and glue paper to them.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> create an artwork with your feet/toes.</p>	<p><b>TEAR IT:</b> create a page full of patterns, tear it up and create something new with the pieces.</p>

# ART CHOICE BOARD

## 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

Week of May 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. Pick one and use any materials you have at home! Challenge yourself!

<p><b>ABSTRACT:</b> Listen to some music and draw an abstract artwork that would go with it. Remember: abstract art is not realistic, so no pictures of real things.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> create a postcard that brings art and Kansas together. What would your postcard from Kansas look like?</p>	<p><b>TAKE IT OUTSIDE:</b> Gather some sticks, grass, leaves, and anything else you can find. Create a landscape out of your materials.</p>
<p><b>ANIMALS:</b> Pick an endangered animal and draw it. Then think about where it lives and create that environment around it.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> find four different patterns in your home. Take those four and mix them in a drawing to create a new pattern.</p>	<p><b>TRY IT:</b> create a monochromatic artwork (using only one color). Example: use a blue marker, blue pen, blue colored pencil, use light blues and dark blues and regular blues only!</p>
<p><b>ART ONLINE:</b> visit <a href="http://www.toytheater.com/category/art/">www.toytheater.com/category/art/</a> and select an online art creation tool to try.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Find an image on something in your house (newspaper, photograph, magazine, old artwork) and change it by adding to it with drawing or gluing stuff on.</p>	<p><b>TABLE TAKEOVER:</b> use random objects you can find in your house and try to create a stacked sculpture with them, how high can you go without using glue?</p>

## 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

Week of May 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. Pick one and use any materials you have at home! Challenge yourself!

<p><b>AROUND THE HOUSE:</b> go on a texture hunt. Find, draw, and label all the textures you can find.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> Pick a story or movie that you like. Change the ending, and then draw what the new ending would look like.</p>	<p><b>TEXT HUNT:</b> hunt for letters to create your own creative alphabet. Once you find a letter, redraw it in the style you find.</p>
<p><b>ART ONLINE:</b> visit <a href="https://pbnify.com/">https://pbnify.com/</a> and create your own Paint By Numbers. Print it. Then color or paint the design you created.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> create a postcard that brings art and Kansas together. What would your postcard from Kansas look like?</p>	<p><b>TRY IT:</b> create a mono-chromatic artwork (using only one color). Example: use a blue marker, blue pen, blue colored pencil, use light blues and dark blues and regular blues only!</p>
<p><b>AGE:</b> Draw what you think McLouth, Kansas, will look like in 100 years.</p>	<p><b>REMIX:</b> create an artwork with your non-dominant hand</p>	<p><b>TAKE IT OUTSIDE:</b> find some leaves, grass, sticks, and/or flowers. Glue them to a piece of paper and draw around them, turning them into something else with your drawings.</p>
