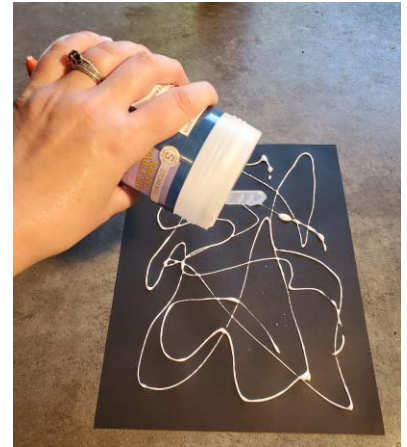


# WATERCOLOR CRAWL



**Step ONE:** using your liquid glue, draw a glue design on your construction paper.

**Step TWO:** while glue is wet, sprinkle salt onto the paper, all over the glue!

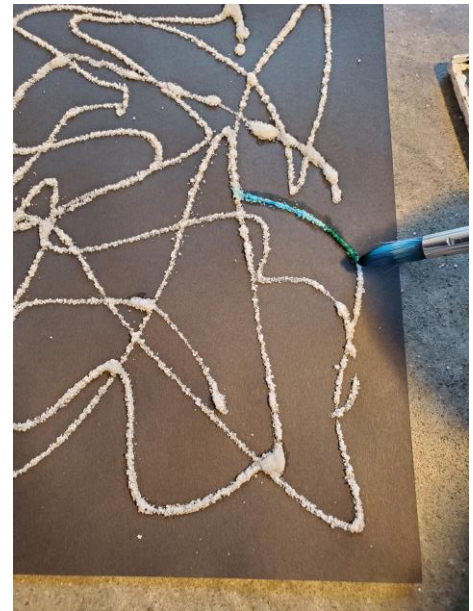


**Step THREE:** shake off the extra salt.



**Step FOUR:** dip your paint brush into water and then into your watercolors, get lots of the color on your brush and then dab your salt/glue lines.

\*if you are using food coloring, put some drops into a bowl so your kiddo can use the brush to pick the liquid color up and dab it.



**Step FIVE:** you will see the watercolor “crawl” along the salt after you dab it, so continue adding colors to your lines until your lines are all colored in!
