Upcoming Events

- **Enrollment:** Friday, August 1, 9am to 7pm. All students need to enroll each year.
- **Back to School Night:** Wednesday, August 13 from 6pm to 7pm for a cold treat in the cafeteria. Students can also bring their materials for the classroom and meet their teachers. This will be a “come and go” event that works best for you.
- **First Day of School:** Friday, August 15. It will be a full day. 8AM to 3:15PM
- **Daily Schedule:** Doors open at 7:35 for breakfast. The school day is 8:00am to 3:15pm

Transportation:

- **Bussing:** If you will require transportation to and from school be certain to complete the yellow form in the enrollment packet and return at enrollment. Your bus driver will be in contact with you prior to the first day of school. Prek students have a separate form through the elementary office.
